

## Introduction

*ArchiveViewer* for *PetroVision* is an auxiliary utility for viewing documents and images in archives of the following formats (format record is case-insensitive):


- Tape archive – *.TAR*
- Roshal ARchiver – *.RAR*
- Archiver by Robert Jung – *.ARJ*
- *.ZIP, .GZ, .TGZ*

You can configure the opening of specific archives and documents contained in them by contacting the support service specialists of Geoleader LLC.

## Launching ArchiveViewer

This application is a utility for navigating through the archive directories, viewing archived documents of the abovementioned formats and is available from *PetroVision* web application.

*ArchiveViewer* is launched automatically by double-clicking on documents of the specified formats or using the icon:




In order to launch *ArchiveViewer* independently of the *PetroVision* software package, you need to contact Geoleader LLC for custom settings. Thus, you can interact not only with the archive, but also with the directories.

# Functionality

This application allows you to open an archive and interact with documents and directories contained in this archive.

The functionality of the *ArchiveViewer* application includes several blocks:

- Navigation buttons
- Directory information
- Archive content - archive documents organized in a table with the following columns:
  - File name
  - Size
  - Date
  - User
  - Group



Each of the listed blocks is described in more detail below.

## Directory information


This component contains the following information:

- relative path from the archive root to the directory (including the archive itself)
- total size of the currently opened directory

## Navigation buttons


### Root directory

This button allows you to return to the initially opened directory.



### Folder up

This button allows you to go to the directory located one level higher.



## Archive content

Any of the documents contained in the archive can be opened by double-clicking on it with the left mouse button. If support for this file type is not configured or it could not be recognized, there will be a question mark to the left of the document 

When opening a file of a graphic type (image), it is possible to switch between images located in the selected directory.
